At Falcons, we really believe that learning extends outside the classroom. Have a look at some of the experiences that our pupils have had this term.

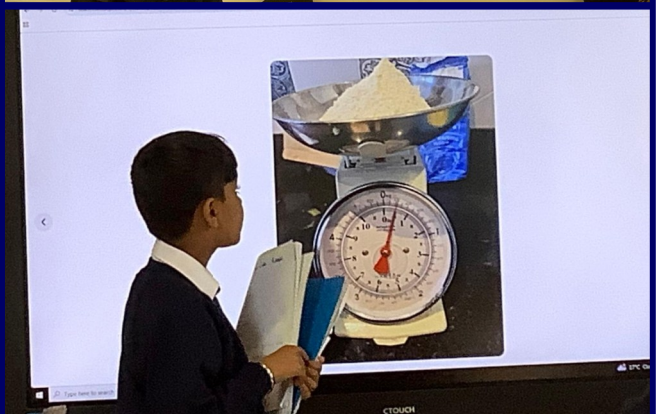
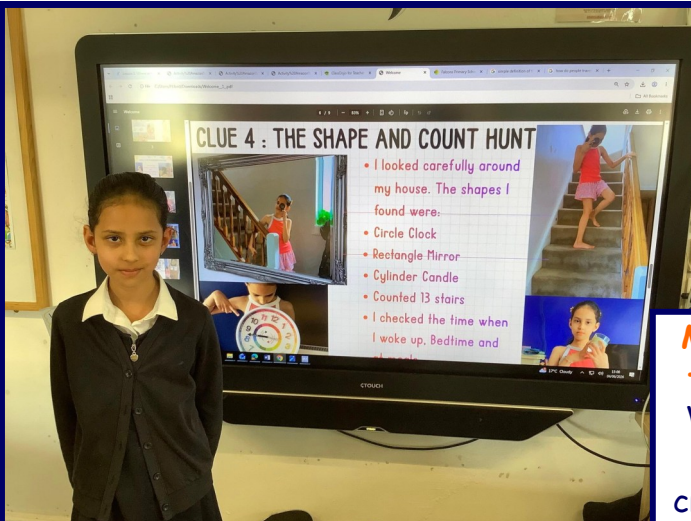


Children from Owls Reception class and the Hive had a fantastic day down on the farm! It was wonderful to see how the children grew in confidence throughout the day.

Well done to all families who created practical activities at home to show how maths is used in everyday life. These Year 3 pupils gave outstanding presentations, explaining their Maths adventures.



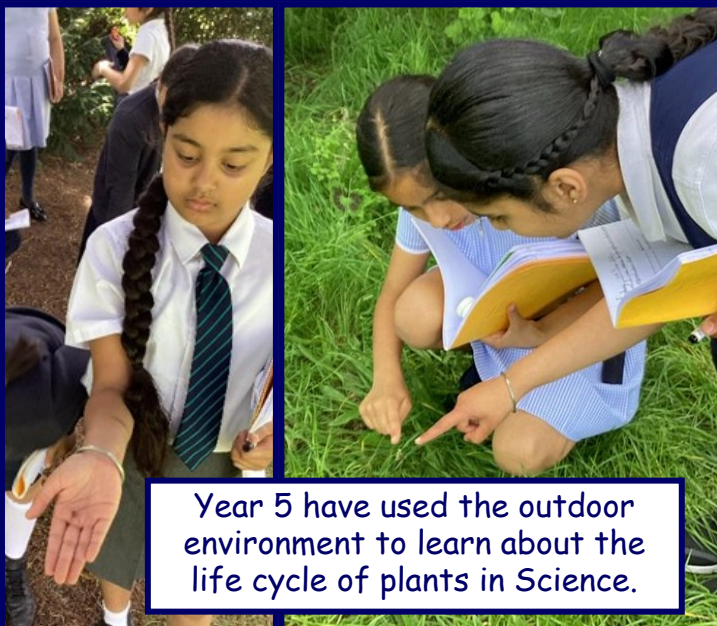


Year 1 pupils enjoyed using our outdoor area to hunt for and identify different leaves.

Year 2 were excited to discover how to identify whether a tree is evergreen or deciduous.



Year 3 pupils had great fun learning outdoors with their Roman and Celtic shields. They explored key differences between the two armies, learning how Roman soldiers fought in organised formations, standing in rows and joining their shields for protection, while Celtic warriors tended to fight more individually, charging freely into battle. Year 3 also discussed the contrasting designs and styles of the shields used by each group.



Year 5 have used the outdoor environment to learn about the life cycle of plants in Science.



Year 6 have been naming and classifying plants outside and used Ipad to record their findings.
