Year 2 have also been working hard on their Geography skills, looking for different species and showing what they found on a bar chart.



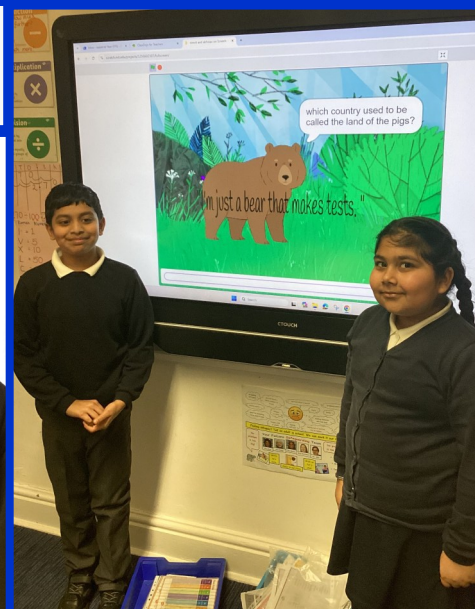
Even P.E. needs great concentration in Year 1, when you're trying to move like different animals!



Year 6 got busy on their 'Ancient Greece' topic and made their own Greek pots from clay.

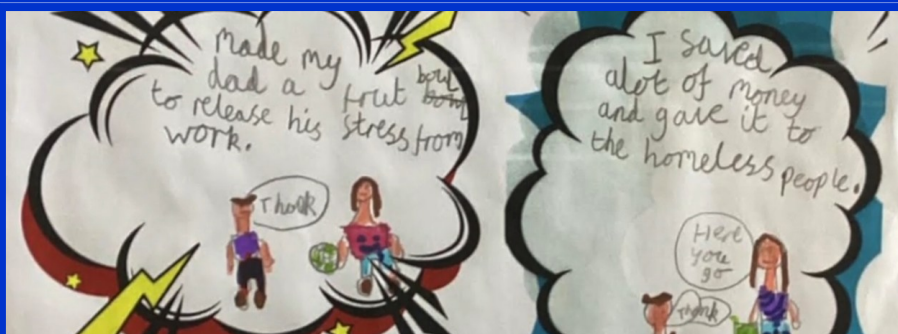


In computing, Year 5 applied their coding and programming skills to create a quiz on their chosen topic. They then enjoyed testing their classmates' and teacher's knowledge!
