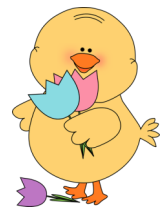
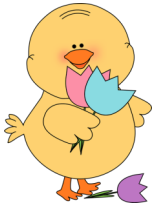

Eid Assembly

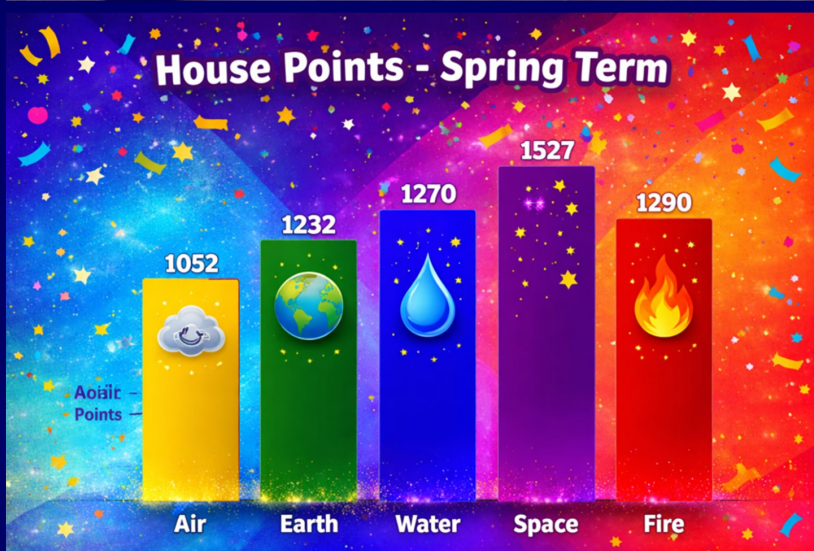
