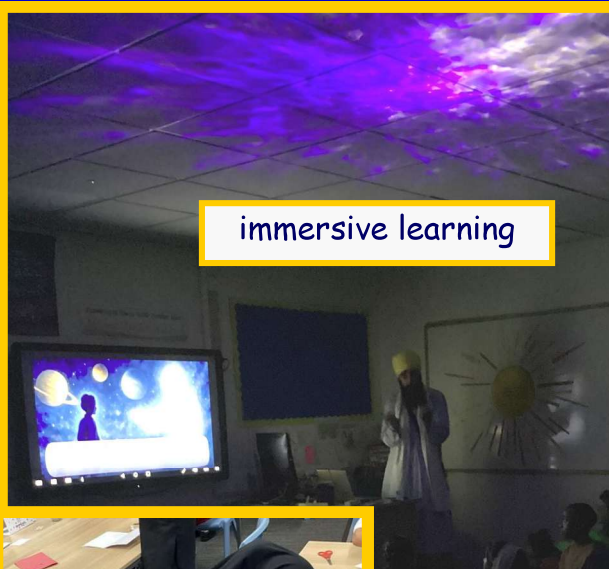
Pupils and staff started Gurmurab Day in spectacular fashion with our own Nagar Kirtan parade through the school grounds.

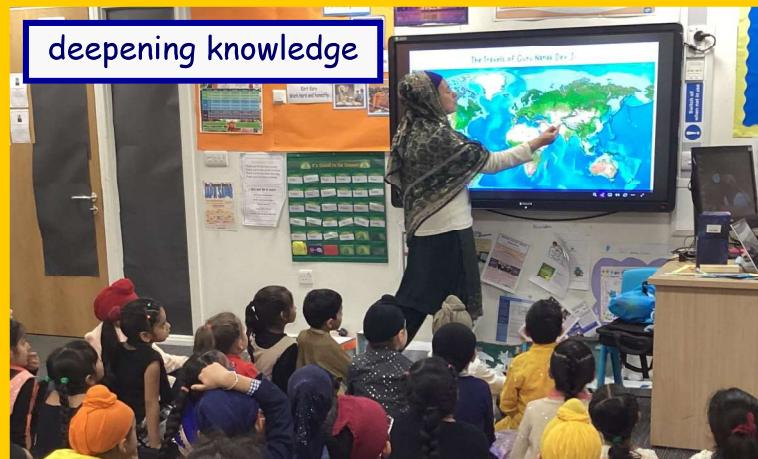


Thank you to Kirtan Club and the groups of pupils who performed Kirtan in the Divaan Hall, and to those who volunteered to do Chaur Sahib.
